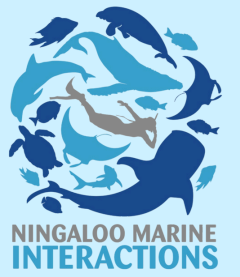


LOCAL LEGENDS YOU SWAM WITH ABOARD UTOPIA

Loggerhead Turtles are listed as endangered under the EPBC Act which means that these species may become extinct if the threats to their survival continue.

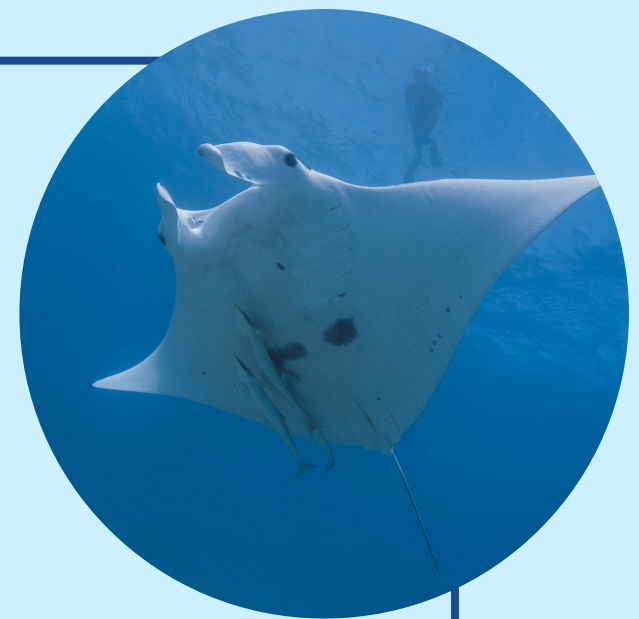
